**RE: Two Year 3 visits: 1). Southbank Centre on Wednesday 9th October; and
2) Southwark Cathedral on Wednesday 23rd October 2024.**

We have organised two visits for the children in Year 3. The first trip is to the **Southbank Centre on Wednesday 9th October 2024** where we will partake in a 'Poetry Explorers' Workshop. The focus of our educational visit is to support and enhance the English curriculum we offer at school as well as celebrate National Poetry Day.

The second visit is to **Southwark Cathedral on Wednesday 23rd October** where the children will take part in a creative 'Climate Justice' Workshop, introducing the topic of climate justice and the impact of changing climate on communities around the world. In addition, the children will contribute to a growing, collective, collaborative artwork programme. The trip also includes a visit to the spectacular Gaia Experience - this exhibit is a giant, 3D planet Earth floating inside the Cathedral nave. The focus of this trip is to enhance the children's Geography, Science and Art curriculum.

On **Wednesday 9th October and Wednesday 23rd October**, for both educational visits, we will be using public transport to travel to and from the sites. Good weather cannot be guaranteed so please ensure your child brings a suitable jacket/raincoat and wears sensible shoes. We will be leaving school shortly after morning registration for both trips. **We will be back at school in time for the normal end of school release for both trips.**

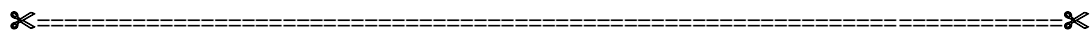
