Our learning this term

This term we will be learning about fairy tales and traditional stories. There will be a big emphasis on children re-telling the stories we are learning about. You can help your child's learning at home by supporting them to re-tell a traditional tale while they are playing. Give them lots of time to remember what happens next but be ready to help them remember what is next in the story.
